**Number of Hours Club Members Worked (if there were shifts, describe):** The event was scheduled to be from 5:00 pm to 7:00 pm. Our volunteers were asked to arrive at 4:45 pm to get instructions and attendees began arriving at 5:00 pm. At around 6:30 pm the organizers decided that it was time to wrap up the event. Our volunteers helped with cleanup and were able to leave around 7:00 pm. This resulted in about 29.25 total volunteer hours.

**How 20-30 Members were Utilized:** The event was Chaired by Emily Schaffner, and Co-Chaired by Sarah Stewart, with assistance from Ashley Weimer. Sarah, Ashley, and Emily Gray went to Northern Lights to pick up pumpkins the previous week. 20-30 Members helped set up food, organize decorating stations, and helped the crafting ensue. Many foster parents attended with their children. Volunteers were given the opportunity to interact and help with the children attending on either a 1-1 or 1-2 ratio, allowing for each child to get focused help and attention, and the parents to relax a little and let the kids be kids.
